Patients are required to have a negative COVID-19 nasal swab screening prior to surgery, to ensure both patient and staff safety.

Our injection clinic is back open, with all doctors now taking appointments for Botox® and filler injections!

We ask that our patients wear a facial covering when arriving for their appointment, while their surgeon wears an N-95 mask during the injection process.

Each treatment room is thoroughly wiped down with hospital grade disinfectant in between patients.

Skin irritation and breakouts are greeting many people at the end of the day when they peel off their mask. Coupled with closed skin care facilities, maintaining healthy skin has been hard work!

"Wash your cloth mask regularly, since bacteria can build up and cause breakouts," said Skin Chic nurse Madi Sommer. "Masks can also dry out your skin, making hydrating treatments like the Hydrafacial a life-saver during these times."

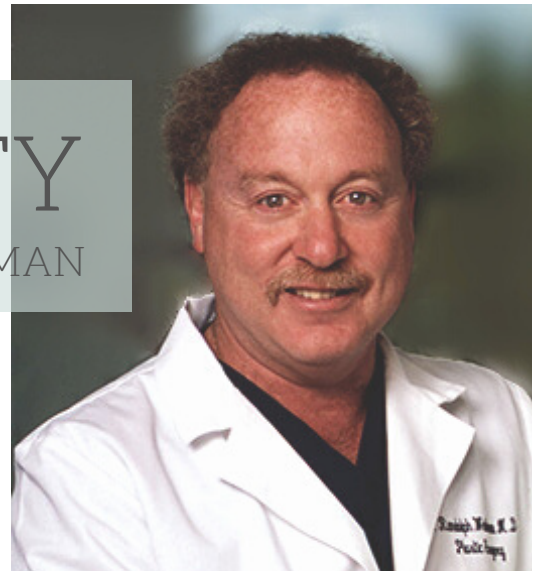
